

Install OTT Navigator on Android, Android TV or Fire TV

Use this guide to install OTT Navigator and configure an M3U playlist or Xstream Codes-compatible account without using an unofficial copy of the app.

The official FAQ lists Downloader code **982469** for the standalone build. Use the TV-specific Google Play listing on Android TV when it is available.

1. Install the correct version

1. Install the phone/tablet or TV listing that matches the device. On Fire TV, use the official standalone download only if the app is not available in the device store.

2. Add a provider

1. Open OTT Navigator, go to **Settings**, open **Provider**, then choose to add a provider.
2. Choose the **Xstream Codes** template when the supplied link contains `get.php?username=` and `password=`. Choose **Playlist** when you have a complete M3U/M3U8 URL.

3. Enter the details

1. **Xstream Codes**: enter the server address, username and password exactly as supplied, then save the provider.
2. **M3U playlist**: paste the remote playlist link. Links are preferred over local files on Android TV devices.

4. Add or refresh the EPG

1. If the playlist does not include guide data, open **Settings - Provider - your provider - Parameters - EPG** and add the XMLTV URL.
2. Go to **Settings - EPG - Reload** and confirm that the source finishes processing.

5. Open the channel list

1. Return to the main screen, open a category and test one channel. Keep advanced codec, buffer and category settings at their defaults until basic playback works.

Important: OTT Navigator has separate official phone/tablet and TV listings. Avoid similarly named apps that are not linked from the official OTT Navigator FAQ.

IPTV player apps do not include channels or a subscription. Only use playlists and streams you are authorised to access.
