

Install Sparkle TV on Android TV, Google TV or Fire TV

Sparkle TV is a television-first DVR/PVR player. Use the steps below to add an authorised M3U playlist or Xstream Codes-compatible source.

Install the official listing by HKAB/Hede Konsulttjänst AB. Store availability can vary on Fire TV, so start from the official Sparkle website.

1. Install and open Sparkle TV

1. Install Sparkle TV from Google Play on Android TV or Google TV. On Fire TV, use the current store route or installation information linked from the official developer site.
2. Open the app and accept the media-player disclaimer if it appears.

2. Add a source

1. Open **Sources** or **Settings - Sources**, then choose **Add source**. The wording can vary slightly by app version.
2. Choose **Xstream Codes API** when you received a server URL, username and password. Choose **Playlist** for an M3U/M3U8 URL.

3. Enter the details

1. **Xstream Codes**: enter the server URL, username, password and a source name.
2. **M3U**: enter the playlist URL. Add the XMLTV EPG URL in the guide field when it is supplied separately.

4. Save and wait for import

1. Save the source and allow channels, categories and guide data to load fully. Open the programme guide and test a channel.

5. Keep advanced features off during testing

1. Start with basic playback before enabling multiple sources, recording, timeshift or multiview. Some functions require Sparkle TV Plus and suitable storage or stream support.

Important: Sparkle TV is a player only. Recording, timeshift and catch-up depend on the app version, device storage and whether the source supports those functions.

IPTV player apps do not include channels or a subscription. Only use playlists and streams you are authorised to access.
