

Install Sparkle TV on a Firestick

These instructions are for Amazon Fire TV devices running Android-based Fire OS. They do not apply to Fire TV devices using Vega OS.

Important: Sparkle TV supports Fire TV according to its official Google Play listing, but the developer does not currently publish an official Firestick Downloader code or a public standalone APK. Use the Amazon Appstore route below. Do not use random codes or third-party APK websites.

1. Search for Sparkle TV in the Firestick Appstore

1. From the Firestick home screen, select **Find** or the search icon.
2. Search for **Sparkle TV Player**.
3. Open the result only when the listing identifies the developer as **HKAB** or **Hede Konsulttjänst AB**.
4. Select **Get** or **Download**, wait for installation, then select **Open**.
5. If the genuine app does not appear for your device or country, do not use an unknown Downloader code or third-party APK. Use another Fire TV player with a verified installation route.

2. Add your IPTV source

1. Open Sparkle TV and accept the media-player disclaimer when it appears.
2. Open **Sources**, or open **Settings** and then **Sources**. Menu wording may vary by version.
3. Select **Add source**.
4. Choose **Xtream Codes API** when you received a server URL, username and password, or choose an **M3U playlist** when you received a complete M3U or M3U Plus URL.
5. Enter the details exactly as supplied, save the source and allow the channel list to finish importing.

Example Xtream-compatible login

Playlist name: My IPTV

Server URL: http://your-server-address.com:port

Username: YOUR USERNAME

Password: YOUR PASSWORD

For an M3U setup, paste the complete M3U or M3U Plus URL. Add a separate XMLTV EPG URL only when one was supplied.

3. Save, import and test

1. Save the source and allow the channel list, categories and guide information to finish importing.
2. Open the programme guide and test one live channel.
3. Test a movie or series only when your authorised source includes VOD.
4. Keep advanced options at their defaults until ordinary playback is working.

4. Basic Firestick troubleshooting

1. Restart Sparkle TV and the Firestick.
2. Go to **Settings > Applications > Manage Installed Applications > Sparkle TV**, select **Force Stop**, then **Clear Cache**.
3. Check the full server address, including **http://** or **https://** and the port number.
4. Remove spaces before or after the username, password and URL.
5. Test the Firestick on a mobile hotspot. This helps separate home-network problems from app or source problems.
6. Use 5 GHz Wi-Fi close to the router, or Ethernet through a compatible adapter, when the signal is weak or congested.

5. About Sparkle TV Plus

Sparkle TV has free basic features and optional Plus features. Recording, timeshift, favourites, multiview, multiple sources and some VOD functions may require Sparkle TV Plus, compatible storage and support from the stream source. Test ordinary playback before paying for a player upgrade.

Safety and compatibility note:

This guide deliberately does not provide a Downloader code or third-party APK. At the time of verification, the official developer sources confirmed Fire TV Stick compatibility but did not publish a public Firestick Downloader code or standalone APK link. Appstore availability can vary by Fire TV model, operating system version, country and account.
